#### **2018 Numbers**

- 32 cases staffed by domestic violence high risk team
- **1,322** women and children found refuge in our emergency shelters
- **18,479** emergency hotline calls were answered by trained advocates
- 410 women and children found independence in our housing program
- 22,293 local students received our evidence-based prevention curriculum
- 97 women received legal representation and assistance at no cost
